


Basic Shapes Box-in Shapes

INSTRUCTION

Drawing an animal begins with identifying the basic shapes of the animal's body. Remember that a basic shape can include a circle, square, oval, or rectangle and can include a variety of angles.


In the example below, the head of the dog is a circle while the body is comprised of two ovals. What other basic shapes are used to form the dog's legs and other features?






Box-in shapes can also be used to help determine proportions of the animal's limbs. In this image of a deer, a large square boxes in the deer's body and legs. The square is then divided into two rectangles to show the placement of the body and legs.







Example of basic shapes and box-in shapes used to draw an animal .











