

Portrait Proportions


INSTRUCTION

Proportions are crucial in portrait drawing. There are some basic rules of proportion that help place facial features.


- 1. The face is divided into 3 sections: hairline to eyebrow, eyebrow to bottom of nose, and nose to chin.
- 2. The eyes are halfway between the top of the head and the bottom of the chin.
- 3. The width between the eyes is equivalent to the width of a single eye.
- 4. The width of the nose is from the inner corner of one to the inner corner of the other.




Depciction of portrait proportions.




Examples of portrait proportions.
